Kalahari and Delta

Private Safari – 7 days/6 nights



Meals: 6 breakfasts, 6 lunches, 6 dinners

DAY 1 – Arrive Maun. Fly to the Kalahari.

On arrival in Maun you will be met by a representative of World Discovery and taken by specially chartered light aircraft to your lodge in the Central Kalahari Game Reserve. Your base for the next 3 days is either the **Grasslands Bushman Lodge**, a family concern whose staff are all local San Bushman, or the Deception Valley Lodge, the Central Kalahari's premier lodge.

Meals included: Lunch, dinner.

DAYS 2 AND 3 - Kalahari.

The Kalahari is famous as the home of the ancient San peoples. As well as learning about the culture and history of these fascinating desert people, there is also opportunity for wildlife viewing. The area is renowned for brown

hyenas, which emerge just after dark, and you may also see black-maned Kalahari lions, giraffes, wildebeest, eland, springbok, and possibly cheetahs and leopards. Enjoy day and night drives with your guide and tracker. Horseback safaris can be arranged for experienced riders.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner each day.

DAYS 4, 5 AND 6 - The Okavango Delta.

After breakfast take a flight by light aircraft to the airstrip shared by **Oddballs' Enclave** and **Delta Camp**, located on Chief's Island in the very heart of the Okavango Delta. Here you will enjoy excursions by *mokoro* (dug-out canoe) or on foot with your own personal guide (one guide is allocated to each tent or chalet). The area supports large numbers of wildlife, including elephants, wildebeests, zebras, giraffes, antelopes and lots of hippos and crocodiles. Birdlife is prolific - you may see bee-eaters, snakebirds, storks, egrets, shrikes, kingfishers, hornbills and herons, as well as birds of prey such as bateleur eagles and African fish eagles and perhaps the rarer Pel's fishing owl. Of the smaller birds, one of the most beautiful and colourful is the lilac breasted roller.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner each day.

DAY 7 - Depart.

In the morning depart by light aircraft for Maun to connect with your homeward flight.

Meals included: Breakfast.

The price includes:

- Flights by light aircraft from Maun to and between the lodges and back, including airport taxes.
- Lodge and private tented accommodation as listed above in twin-bedded or double rooms with ensuite facilities.
- 6 breakfasts, 6 lunches and 6 dinners as shown in the itinerary.
- Soft drinks, house wine, local beer, teas and coffees.
- Laundry.
- Transportation throughout: this will be shared with other guests at the lodges and camps.
- All gameviewing as shown, including guiding and park entrance fees.

Not included in the price:

- International flights (see website page). We are happy to discuss the flights with you and give you further guidance.
- International airport taxes.
- Tipping. We will give you guidance in this often sensitive matter

A deposit of 20% of the selling price is required at the time of booking, plus the cost of the international airfare and service charge if World Discovery is booking the flights on your behalf. The balance of the price for your Botswana Safari arrangements must be paid at least 8 weeks before your departure date.
