## Mara Migration Special

Private Safari – 5 days/4 nights



Meals: 4 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 4 dinners

### DAY 1 – Arrive Nairobi.

On arrival in Nairobi, Kenya's capital city, you will be met by a representative of World Discovery and taken by private transportation to the unique Nairobi Tented Camp, the only accommodation within Nairobi National Park. In the afternoon enjoy your first game drive. With sweeping plains on one side and Nairobi city on the other, Nairobi National Park is a wildlife haven unlike any other, with guaranteed sightings of rhino a reason in itself to visit; there's also a good chance of seeing hippos, giraffes, large herds of buffalo, zebra and impala and the occasional cheetah or lion.

**Meals included: Lunch, dinner.**

### DAY 2 – By road to the Masai Mara.

After an early breakfast depart by road towards the Masai Mara. You will arrive at the Mara Bush Camp in the Ol Kinyei Conservancy in time for lunch. Located within the Serengeti-Mara eco-system, Ol Kinyei is renowned for its unspoilt and breathtaking scenery with diverse terrain offering on one hand open savannah plains and rolling hills on the other. With its abundance of water sources in the form of springs, streams and rivers, coupled with spectacular views across the Mara plains, the land is home to a wide variety of animal species. There is a resident lion pride of over 20 animals and several leopards also have their territories within the conservancy and are often sighted by guests from Porini Bush Camp on evening or early morning drives. Cheetahs are frequently seen and it is not rare to come across large numbers of giraffe as well as Cape buffalo and elephant. In the late afternoon enjoy your first game drive in the Conservancy. Stop for sundowners at a scenic view point. Return to camp for dinner and overnight.

**Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.**

### DAY 3 – Masai Mara National Reserve.

Spend the day in the Masai Mara National Reserve (with a picnic lunch). The Mara is famous for the annual Wildebeest Migration (one of the Natural Wonders of the World) which occurs from June to October when the Mara becomes host to an almost unimaginable half a million wildebeest seeking the grasses raised by the Spring rains of April and May. Having exhausted the grazing in the northern Serengeti the wildebeest head north en masse. This is an awesome sight in the true meaning of the word which, when coupled with the sound of thousands upon thousands of hooves pounding the earth, makes it an unforgettable spectacle. Return to the Porini Bush Camp in the late afternoon. In the evening head out for a game drive – with sundowner stop, of course! – in the Ol Kinyei Conservancy. Continue on a night drive in search of nocturnal animals.

**Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.**

#### **DAY 4 – Mara Naboisho Conservancy.**

Today you have a chance to explore the adjacent Mara Naboisho Conservancy, a 50,000 acre wilderness with a broad range of species. After a picnic lunch continue with an afternoon game drive, followed again by a welcome sundowner at a scenic viewpoint and a further night drive, before returning to your camp for overnight.

**Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.**

#### **DAY 5 – Guided Bush Walk. Return to Nairobi. Depart for home.**

Take an early morning walk in the Ol Kinyei Conservancy escorted by Masai warriors, returning for a hearty breakfast before departing back to Nairobi by road. Upon arrival in Nairobi you will be dropped off at your hotel (if you are staying on in Kenya) or at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in time for your homeward flight.

**Meals included: Breakfast.**

#### **The price includes:**

- Tented camp accommodation as listed above in twin-bedded units with ensuite facilities.
- 4 breakfasts, 4 lunches and 4 dinners as shown in the itinerary.
- Soft drinks, beer, house wine, gin & tonic, mineral water.
- Transfers by air-conditioned minivan.
- On safari you will be in an open-sided 4x4 safari vehicle with English-speaking driver/guide.
- All gameviewing as shown.
- Conservancy and National Park entrance fees.
- Kenya Government taxes.
