Private Safari – 8 days/7 nights

DAY 1 – Arrive Nairobi.

On arrival in Kenya's capital Nairobi you will be met by a representative of World Discovery outside immigration and customs. You will then be taken by road to the Amboseli Porini Camp, located in the Selenkay Conservancy in view of Africa's iconic highest mountain, the permanently snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro. The Selenkay Conservancy is a 15,000 acre private game reserve within a vast tract of land owned by the Kisonko clan of the Maasai people. It is well off the beaten track and the animals are truly wild and tend to behave more naturally than those in the nearby national park.

Meals included: Lunch, dinner.

DAY 2 - Amboseli Porini Camp.

In addition to the better-known game like elephant, lion, cheetah, giraffe and zebra, there are several less common species such as caracal, African wildcat, civet, gerenuk, lesser kudu and striped hyena. The camp's four-wheel-drive track links the Selenkay Conservancy the Amboseli National Park so that you have the advantage of game drives in the park as well as in the exclusive private reserve.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

DAY 3 - Fly to Nanyuki. Transfer to OI Pejeta Conservancy.

Fly via Nairobi's Wilson Airport to Nanyuki, located on the Equator, where you will be met and taken to the Porini Rhino Camp in the OI Pejeta Conservancy. This 90,000 acre wildlife conservancy is situated between the foothills of the Aberdares and the magnificent snow-capped Mount Kenya.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

DAY 4 - Porini Rhino Camp.

OI Pejeta Conservancy boasts an astounding variety of animals including all the 'Big Five' as well as a sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees; it also incorporates the smaller Sweetwaters Game Reserve, the largest sanctuary in East Africa for the endangered Black Rhino.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

DAY 5 - Fly to the Maasai Mara.

Today you will take a flight to Kenya's most famous wildlife location - the Maasai Mara National Reserve. Transfer to the Porini Lion Camp in the exclusive Olare Orok Conservancy, a small 20,000 acre conservancy which borders the Maasai Mara and which is home to an abundance of animals including the Big Cats for which the Mara is famous.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.

DAYS 6 AND 7 - Porini Lion Camp.

Enjoy two full days of activities, including a full day in the Maasai Mara with picnic lunch. Activities at the camp include escorted walks with Maasai guides, sundowner drinks to watch the sunset from scenic viewing points and evening and night game drives in the Olare Orok Conservancy.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner each day.

DAY 8 - At leisure. Depart.

Morning activities. In the afternoon transfer to Ol Kiombo Airstrip for the flight to Nairobi's Wilson Airport. You will be met and taken to Nairobi's international airport for your departure flight.
